The Investment Clause

Probably the investment clause is one of the most important in the bill and one in which there will be the most interest. The present act authorizes investment in a class of public securities such as Imperial, Dominion, provincial securities, etc.

As to the manner in which the act shall be brought into operation it would be manifestly unfair...

"Next, we provide for investment in the preferred stock of companies which have paid dividends of four per cent. or more for seven years. Finally we provide for investment in common stock of companies which have paid dividends of not less than five per cent. for a period of ten years.
