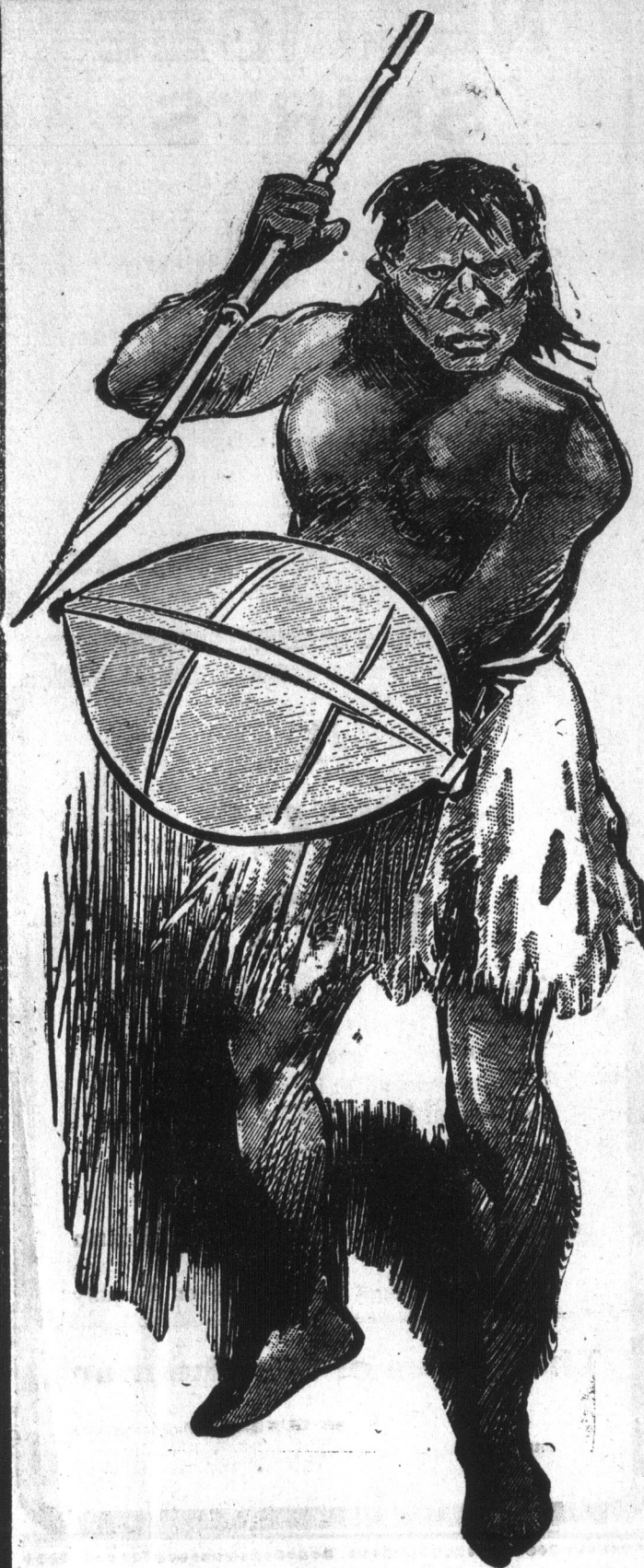


The Secret of the Natives
