OTAWA, March 6.—The report of the committee on the proposed Labrador railway bill, strongly recommends the government to take steps to prohibit fishing with purse seines, otherwise the mackerel fisheries will be depleted.

A government bill to amend the law relating to provincial governments was introduced today.

Five tariff delegations and two railway delegations are here today.

Petitions have been presented in favor of uniform postage to the British Empire.

OVER THE RIVER.

Children Entering Uncle Sam's Dominion from Sarria.

Five of an Organized Gang of Smugglers with Agencies in Victoria and Most of the Eastern Cities.

CHICAGO, March 6.—A special from Detroit, Mich., gives particulars of a gang of smugglers who are active in the United States. Last Thursday, acting on information received on Wednesday, that an invoice of opium was being sent to the United States, the United States Customs, and Local Inspector Green placed themselves on the watch, and discovered four Chinamen who had brought over a large quantity of opium. The four followed them to Tick Chang's habitation. After seeing them safely in their boats, they broke open the boxes and established and arrested the proprietor and a stranger, one Wong Sing, but the others escaped. A closer investigation revealed the Celestials hiding under a dock in a shed in the city. All were locked up. On their persons were twenty-six letters addressed to the most firms in Canada and the United States. They all had cards showing they had to go, this card being addressed to Queen's Quay, 220 Bay Street, Charleston, W. Va. They also had complete opium outfits. It appears from the evidence that Tick Chang had contracted to pass all his contraband, for which service he receives \$30 per month. Following the arrest of the leader and two to Detroit, Wednesday and two others followed, and Wednesday the others caught in the act of passing opium. The methods employed and the documents secured, including a list of names of Chinamen, Toronto, London, Sarria, and the principal American cities, were all taken care of. Commissioner Harris and sent back to the United States.

CANADIAN NEWS.

Railway Legislation.

OTTAWA, March 6.—The legislature has adopted the bill of the proposed short line to the sea. It is expected that the Federal Government will grant a subsidy of \$8,300 a mile in the Maritime Provinces, 210 miles from Malakoff to Moncton, 210 miles from Moncton to St. John's, and the Grand Trunk extension to the Maritime Provinces. The line will run from River Du Loup, New Brunswick, through Canada territory.
