**Death of Dr. Dow.**

The *Fredericton* regrets to announce the death  
of Dr. William Dow, ex-M. P., which oc-  
curred at a quarter to eleven o'clock this fore-  
noon.

Dr. Dow was born at Lincolnton, Ver-  
mont, U. S., on Christmas 1825, and was  
therefore in his fifty-ninth year. He came  
to Fredericton about 1848, and practiced his  
profession with marked success, for thirty  
years. In 1869 he was elected to the Legis-  
lative Assembly for York, leading the pol-  
lards without opposition till 1870, when  
he was defeated. He was again re-elected  
in 1874, and defeated in 1878. Dr. Dow  
was a warm friend of Free Schools. He had  
a wide acquaintance in York County, and  
his death was a loss to the community.

**Personal Scandal in American  
Politics.**

If a man desires to have his personal and  
political life raised up, and served in the  
"room to the all too eager readers, he ought to  
read for office in the United States. The  
present Presidential campaign perhaps, serves  
as the best illustration of malignity and abuse  
ever witnessed in the Republic. Both par-  
ties are equally guilty of its use, and each  
seems to outdo the other in raking up  
scandals which if they ever existed, were  
long since forgotten. Governor Cleveland  
has recently received the nomination of the  
Democrats for the Presidency, before a Buf-  
falo paper published the alleged facts of a  
scandal in which Cleveland and a certain  
widow of that city had been involved several  
years ago. He was accused of debauchery,  
adultery, drunkenness and libertinism in his  
youth. When asked by his friends what  
reply he had to make to these accusations,  
Cleveland replied, "Let them tell the  
truth," and his enemies have been telling  
something, whether it is the truth or not,  
ever since with a vehemence that is unparal-  
leled. From what has been published by  
newspapers friendly to Cleveland, it would  
appear that he has been guilty of indiscre-  
tions, but not of so serious a character, as his  
enemies represent. His great object has  
been to bring improper intimacy with the  
widow in question, who afterwards took to  
drinking, illustrated her child, which was taken  
from her by Cleveland's order and placed in  
an orphan asylum, while his mother was  
taken to an insane asylum. These facts  
were sufficient to found a story of seduction,  
kidnapping and brutality, which is now be-  
ing used against Cleveland, and apparently  
so without effect.

**An Important British Colony.**

An expressed desire of some of the leading  
people of Jamaica to have their island an-  
nexed to the Dominion of Canada has called  
attention to the resources and other interest-  
ing features of this important British Colony.  
Jamaica is the largest of the British  
West India Islands and lies between the  
Caribbean Sea and the Gulf of Mexico, about  
eighty miles eastward of the western ex-  
tremity of Cuba. Its area is about four  
thousand two hundred square miles, and in  
1871 its population was returned as 500,000,  
of whom 18,000 only were white. The total  
value of its exports in 1879 was \$1,385,871,  
and its imports \$1,848,942. Its chief ex-  
ports are sugar, rum and tobacco, and large  
quantities of cigars of superior quality are  
now being manufactured. The capital of the  
colony is Kingston, which as a population of  
40,000. Who will be bold enough to say that  
the time is far distant that will witness all  
of the British possessions on the continent of  
North America at least under the authority  
of one Dominion, and that of Canada.

**A VETERAN JOURNALIST**

Who has run the same Newspaper  
for Fifty-one Years.

Alexander Lawson, of Yarmouth, Nova  
Scotia, is probably the only man living of  
whom it can be said that he has edited and  
published the same newspaper for fifty-one  
years without a break. He is still well and  
active and enjoys the labors of the interest-  
ing work in which he has lived so long with  
the appreciation of a vigorous old age. He is a  
Scotchman by birth, but became a resident of  
Nova Scotia when a boy. His connection  
with newspaper work began in the office of  
the *Yarmouth Telegraph*, a paper published in  
Pictou, and then the newspaper in the Province  
of Halifax. Fifty years later he had become  
the proprietor of the *Yarmouth Telegraph*, and  
Mr. Lawson is still its editor and publisher.  
There are very few men in the world who have  
lived so long in the same newspaper office, and  
who have been so successful in their work.
