## DESCRIPTION OF JEWELS.

1. The Jewel or Badge of the Order for membership generally is a white Malta Cross edged with gold, on which rests a black triangular plate with a gold border. On the black plate is a spray of red and white roses and blue forget-me-nots. On the gold border of the triangle is the motto, "Crux mea anchora est."
