DEAR BRO. MUNRO :- I intended to write before this late date, but the multitude of dunes has prevented.

The summer for a missionary in Japan is either one of heat in the city or invigorating coolness on the mountains or at the sea shore. Most of the missionaries leave Tokyo in the summer. They go about the middle of July, and return about the middle of September.

This is the first summer that we have left Tokyo. Freling the need of rest and change, we decided to go to the sea near to Shonai. This is the place where we spent our first year in Japan. For such a trip into the interior there is not the least objection or difficulty in obtaining a passport. The objection is where you go for a purpose for which passports are not granted. For example, a person will take out a passport which he must sign for health or scientific purposes, when at the same time he goes for none of these purposes, but to do evangelistic work.

We had been away from Shonai three years. Our company consisted of my own family, Bro. McCaleb, and our servants-daughter and mother. Our servants' home is in Shonai. They have been with us since we came to Japan. It was a great pleasure to them to go back to Shonai, their native place; for they had now been away three years.
