

The Quebec Tercentenary

The significance of the celebration to be held at Quebec in July will be well observed in the July number of *The Canadian Magazine* with an article on the Ancient Capital by Mr. John A. Ewan, and another on the Empire-BUILDER Pitt, by Dr. A. H. U. Colquhoun. Appropriate illustrations will accompany the articles. In recalling the actual taking of Quebec by Wolfe, one is likely to lose sight of the important part played by the first Pitt, but Dr. Colquhoun, in a timely article, makes a fair adjustment of the balance.
