FLOUR, GRAIN, ETC. Flour—Receipts during the past week were 11,632 bushels, against 27,297 bushels for the week previous.

Wheat—Receipts during the past week were 444,294 bushels, against 332,143 bushels for the week previous. The market has ruled quiet on spot with values nominal. No. 1 hard Manitoba being quoted at 70c to 80c and at 73c to 75c at Fort William.

Corn—Receipts during the past week were 48,415 bushels, against 79,758 bushels for the week previous. The market is quiet and steady at 30c to 32c for American and Ontario yellow.

Beans—Receipts during the past week were 3,210 bushels, against 47,898 bushels for the week previous. The market is quiet at 31c to 32c for feed, and purely nominal for malting at 38c to 40c.
