ARTICLE 23

Entry into Force and Termination

- 1. This Treaty shall enter into force on the date of the later of the Notes notifying the other Party that the requirements for entry into force of this Treaty have been complied with.
- 2. This Treaty shall apply to any requests presented after its entry into force even if the relevant acts or omissions occurred before that date.
- This Treaty shall remain in force for an indefinite period of time until terminated by either Contracting Party giving six (6) months written notice of termination to the other Contracting Party through the diplomatic channel.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the undersigned, being duly authorized thereto by their respective Governments, have signed this Treaty.

DONE in duplicate at Ottawa on the 35th day of Ottober 1999, corresponding to the 15th day of Heshvan, 5760, in the English, French and Hebrew languages, each version being equally authentic.
