PRAYERS.

On motion of Mr. Guthrie, it was resolved,—That when this House adjourns on Thursday the 10th of November, 1932, it stand adjourned until Monday the 14th of November, 1932.

Mr. Gordon, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House, by command of His Excellency the Governor General,—Annual Report of the Department of Immigration and Colonization, for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1932.

Sir George Perley, a Member of the King's Privy Council, for Mr. Cahan, laid before the House, by command of His Excellency the Governor General,—Annual Report of the Department of Public Printing and Stationery for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1932.

Mr. Stevens, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Statement of Dominion Bureau of Statistics showing wage earners of Canada at work and not at work on June 1, 1931, together with causes as stated by wage earners reporting as "not at work" (preliminary figures).

The House resumed the adjourned Debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Bennett for the second reading of Bill No. 8, An Act respecting a certain Trade Agreement between His Majesty's Government in Canada and His Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom.
