Hon. Monique Bégin (Minister of National Health and Welfare): 1 and 2. Departmental officials have documented precedents and interpretations with respect to the program conditions which have evolved since the Hospital Insurance and Diagnostic Services Act and the Medical Care Act were passed. These have been provided to Mr. Justice Emmett Hall who is conducting the Health Services Review '79. It is hoped
