

Supply

Perhaps there is a sense above all of sadness about the agreement because alternatives existed. Different approaches could have given us jobs, given us reasonable trade relations with the United States, and given us much more prosperity for the future. We have passed those up. We have before us an agreement which will hurt Canadians, will leave Canadians much more vulnerable than they have been, and will seriously restrict the freedom of the country in respect of all our economic policy-making in the future.

It is for that reason that we have moved the amendment, and we oppose the agreement which has been placed before the country.
