

CONTRACT FOR ENGAGEMENT
"THE WEST AUSTRALIAN
UNIVERSITY FAR EAST AND
AMERICA DEBATE TOUR".

NATURE OF TOUR:- The Debating Society of the University of Western Australia is sending a three man debate team to meet Universities in Singapore, China, Japan, the United States, Canada, New Zealand and Australia. This tour will officially represent the University of Western Australia and will be of the nature of a good-will mission. Starting with Singapore in November 1932 the team will travel through China and Japan, thence to Vancouver and through the United States of America to Canada. From San Francisco to Hawaii and New Zealand and back to Australia. The tour will cover approximately twelve months.

In addition to debates the team will deliver lectures under the auspices of various organisations in cities included in the itinerary.

The members of the team, while on tour, will make a study of the problems of the countries visited.

STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT:- It is hereby agreed by the Debating Society of the University of Western Australia and the McGill University Debating Union Society

SUBJECTS FOR DEBATES:- The subjects for debate shall be as follows (Please indicate the subjects chosen by a cross and also by the same means indicate whether the negative or affirmative is desired)

-1 That Imperialism is a menace Aff....Neg....
-2 That Communism is a menace Aff....Neg....
-3 That the abolition of all Tariffs is desirable Aff....Neg....
-4 That modern civilisation is decadent Aff....Neg....
-5 That India should be given her independence immediately Aff....Neg....
-6 That all immigration legislation discriminating between nationalities should be repealed Aff....Neg....
-7 That marriage as a sociological factor is obsolete Aff....Neg....
-8 That world peace demands the demobilisation of all armed forces excepting those necessary for police protection Aff....Neg....

In addition to the above, the Far East and America Debaters will be prepared to debate any economic or social question not peculiar to the country concerned provided sufficient notice is given.
