



This meeting of the Association will be conducted under the direction of an Executive Committee of five members, to be named by the Council.

Competitors must make themselves fully acquainted with the Regulations, as also with the conditions of the Match for which they may have entered, as in no case will the plea of ignorance be entertained.

They must refer to the Notice Board Morning and Afternoon, to ascertain whether orders have been issued altering the original detail of the shooting affecting them in any way.

REGULATIONS.

MEMBERSHIP. All competitions, except the Goldstream, No. 6, and the Extra and Pool (which are open to all comers) are restricted to Members of the British Columbia Rifle Association who have paid membership fee of \$2.00 for 1895.

RIFLES. The rifles used in these competitions shall be either Martini-Henry or Snider, except in the Goldstream Match, in which the use of the Lee-Metford or Martini-Metford is permitted.
