5. After His Excellency's reply, the procession will march in the above order towards Government House; at a short distance from the grounds it will halt at a word of command. All preceding His Worship and Aldermen will face inwards and step back to either side of the road and allow the remainder of the procession to pass in between.

6. After all the carriages have passed into the grounds the Societies and Fire Department will reform and follow them, the procession going out at the North gate and dispersing at pleasure.
