Mr. Smith has over 400 acres under cultivation, about equally divided into fruit, grain and nursery, and employs 70 men during the fruit season, and at the present time 120 men are busy shipping nursery stock to many different points of the Dominion. Mr. Smith commenced to ship bis nursery stock on the 11th and expected to be through on the 20th of April, having shipped daily 50 boxes 10 feet long and 30 inches square, using over 40,000 feet of lumber in manufacturing these boxes.

The trees and plants that were being shipped were as fine, stock as could be desired, and he will be prepared to ship double the quantity next year.

Mr. Smith has great hopes and faith in his business, as well as in his country, and says that the acreage will increase tenfold in ten years.


