OTTAWA MEETING

National Railways, to the Mayors of ten of the important cities of Canada. Places represented besides St. John were Vancouver, Winnipeg, Calgary. Edmonton, Montreal, Hamilton, Ottawa and Hallfax. These city officials had exchanged views and information. Mayor Potts said he was greatly surprised to learn how little one part of Canada knew about the others.

The delegates had been allowed a great deal of latitude in expressing their views during the debates on the subject at the conference, the Mayor said, and he believed a deal of good had resulted. He had suggested, when the subject of unemployment here was spoken of, that we could take care of our own unemployed if the other parts of the Dominion would co-operate by shipping their wheat through Marltime ports during the winter instead of using those of the United States. Another help to employment would be the erection of the new Canadian National station in St. John, he contended.
