Automobiles are still to be barred from the public highways in Bermuda, according to a recent decision of the local cording to a recent decision of the local government, which also rejected the offer of an American company to build an electric trolley line from Hamilton to St. George, a distance of twenty miles. Both matters have been presented for consideration during the last ten years and have been regularly turned down.

In the absence of autos the bicycle reigns supreme in Bermuda, as a majority of the able-bodied inhabitants use the wheel and a lrage proportion of visitors adopt the same custom. The roads of Bermuda, well laid and as smooth as asphalt, are exceptionally well adapted to bicycling.

The Araguaya, which has been employed in the Royal Mail's South American service between Southampton, Rio de Janeiro and Buenos Aires, will be the largest steamer ever employed for Bermuda passenger traffic and also the most luxurious.
