

## FOSSIL SOUP TAKES PLACE OF GLANDS

Everlasting Vitality and Strength Claimed For Concoction in China.

LONDON, May 28.—Monkey gland treatment is positively a western experiment. Any way, the inhabitants of the Chinese hinterland know nothing about it. Their pet theory for everlasting vitality and strength is "fossil soup."

This primitive idea of medicine was the basis of a lecture delivered at the Central Hall, Manchester, by the Rev. Thomas Darlington, a member of the China Inland Mission in north London. In describing the locality where the fossils are found, Darlington declared that the fossil field covered an area of 75 square miles about 15 miles south-west of the city of Wanhien, Szechwan. In this area land-owners farm out plots to "miners" who sink pits. The results of their work are exported to various parts of China to medicine dealers, who grind them and use them for tonics. The bigger bone the more powerful the medicine. "Get cured on fossil soup" is becoming a popular slogan in many parts of China.

## THIEVES STEAL FROM PASTOR'S HOME

Minister Then Says Crime Due to Lack of Religious Training.

NEW YORK, May 28.—Speaking on "Security Against Thieves" at the Broadway Temple and Chelsea Methodist Church the Rev. Dr. Christian F. Reiser revealed that since he announced his text earlier in the week his home had been entered by thieves who took jewelry of "great sentimental value."

After expressing his admiration for the police for their efficiency in investigating the theft in his home, Dr. Reiser said that statistics reveal that 85 per cent. of the criminals in America have received no religious training.

"We rave over the crime wave," he said, "and charge it to prohibition, to disintegration of the police force and to other things, but in the face of this fact we ought to be roused by the consciousness that seven out of every ten of the children of America are growing up without any systematic religious training."
