The object of this Society is to bring together all those who have studied at Mount Allison, either in the College or the Academy, and to ensure the life-long devotion of Mount Allison's sons to their Alma Mater. All old students are cordially invited to become members. With a view of increasing the membership, the annual fee was reduced, a few years ago, to one dollar. The funds of the Society have been devoted in past years to paying off a subscription of \$1,000 to the Endowment of the College, to furnishing scholarships to students of the College and Academy, and to adding to the Alumni Reference Library in the College. A series of resolutions with reference to nominating candidates to represent the Alumni Society on the Board of Regents, and to enable members who cannot be present to cast a vote for the same, was adopted at the regular meeting in May, 1892.
