My Lord, I have the honor to report that I intend to leave Victoria tomorrow in Her Majesty's Ship Sparrowhawk" for the purpose of vioiting bowichan. Maraimo, & Comor on the East Coast of Vancouver Island and Inighto Inlet and some other places on the Coast of the Mainland. at Inights Inlet there have been some disputes between the Indian Tibe in that neigh hourhood, and a party engaged in endeavouring to open what is represented as likely to be a very valuable mine of Copper Ore. and I hope that my visit may terminate the misunderstanding. I shall probably be about from the Seat of Government about a fortnight, but ocarcely in any case more than three weeks, I have the honor to be, My Lord, Your most obedient humble Dervant a.
