

Applicant must appear in person at Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for District. Entry by proxy may be made on certain condi-tions. Duties-six months residence upon and cultivation of land in each of three years. In certain districts a homestender may secure an adjoining quarter-section

turnings and special wood work. Holders of entries may count time of employment as farm labourers in Canada during 1917, as residence duties under certain conditions. When Bominion Lands are advertised or posted for entry, returned soldiers who have served overseas and have been hon-ourably discharged, receive one day prior-ity in applying for entry at local agent's Office (but not Sub-Agency) Discharge papers must be presented to Agent.
