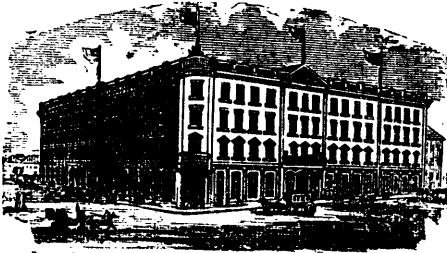


# ROYAL HOTEL,

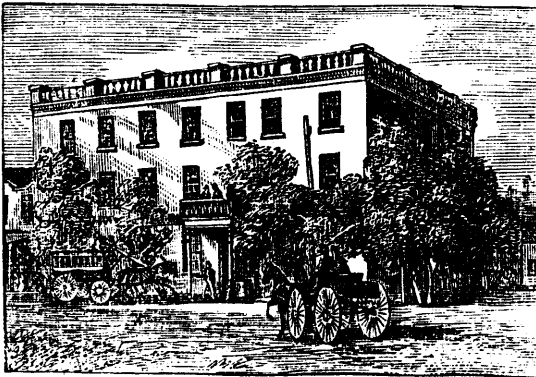
