GRAHAM, PETER, J.P. (*East Lambton*.)

S. of Mr. Thomas Graham, of Kirkoswald, Cumberland, Eng., who emigrated to Can., 1834. B. at Kirkoswald, 16 July, 1821. Ed. at a Common Sch. in Eng. After his arrival in Can., served as a volunteer in suppressing the Rebellion in 1837. Is a farmer. Has held the office of Councillor, Deputy Reeve of Warwick, in succession; and has also been Presdt. of the Lambton Agricultural Soc. First returned to Legislative Assem. at g.e. 1875; re-elected at g.e. 1879, 1883, and again at last g.e. A Liberal, and a supporter of Mr. Mowat.—*Warwick*.

GUTHRIE, DONALD, Q.C. (*South Wellington*.)

S. of the late Mr. Hugh Guthrie, of Edinburgh, Scot., by his wife Catherine, dau. of Mr. John McGregor, of Rannock, Perthshire, Scot. B. in Edinburgh, 8 May, 1840. Ed. there, and afterwards in Toronto. M. at Montreal, 17 Dec., 1863, Eliza Margaret, youngest dau. of the late Mr. John MacVicar, of Chatham Tp., Ont., formerly of Dungle, Argyshire. Admitted as an Attorney, U.C., 1863, and called to the Bar, Ont., Trinity Term, 1866. Apptd. a Q.C. by Lieut.-Gov. of Ont. in 1876, and in 1885 by Gov.-General. A Bencher of Law Soc. of Ontario since 1882. Has been for 17 years Presdt. of the Guelph Gas Light Co. A dir. of the Guelph Junction Railway, and of the Wellington Hotel Co. Sat in the Commons for South Wellington from 5 July, 1876, until g.e. 1882. First returned to Leg. Assem. at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Guelph*.

HAMMELL, WILLIAM HENRY. (*Cardwell*.)

Parents emigrated from Irel. about 1828. B. in Tp. of Tecumseth, and ed. at Rockwood Academy. M., 1878, Maggie, dau. of Thos. Robinson, Esq., and grand-d of the late Dr. Robinson, Co. of Peel. Is a farmer. Has been a School Trustee, Secy.-Treas., of Tecumseth Agricultural Soc., Treas. of the Co. of Cardwell Agricultural Soc., Deputy Reeve of Tecumseth, and a dir. and Vice-Presdt. of the Simcoe Mutual Fire Insur. Co. First returned to Leg. Assembly. at g.e. 1883, and re-elected at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Beeton, Ont.*
