An Act respecting Mining Rights.

HEREAS doubts have arisen as to the extent of the rights of Preamble. purchasers of mining claims and privileges severed from the soil; for remedy thereof, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as 5 follows:

1. The sale of any mining right or privilege of exploration, with or sale of mining without the power of working the mine, or right of access and egress there- rights duly to and therefrom, if duly registered, shall vest in the purchaser the property therein, to the extent expressed in the contract so registered, and out tradition. 10 he shall be as fully seized and possessed thereof as though he had obtained actual tradition and seizin, and no subsequent sale by the vendor to any third, party of the property in, upon or respecting which such first mentioned sale was made, shall defeat, weaken or injure the same.
