
ROYAL INSTRUCTIONS

Relating to the Enactment of Laws by the Parliament of the Province of Canada, communicated to the Legislative Council on the 16th September 1841, by order of His Excellency the Governor General.

“ And for the execution of so much of the powers vested in you by our said Commission, and by virtue of the said Act passed in the third and fourth years of our Reign as aforesaid, as relates to the declaring that you assent in our name to Bills passed by the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, and that you withhold our assent therefrom, or that you reserve such Bills for the signification of our Royal Pleasure thereon, it is our will and pleasrue that you do carefully observe the following Rules, Directions and Instructions, namely :
