## C A P. LXII.

An Act to permit Rum and other Spirits, the Produce of the *British Colonies* in the *West Indies*, to be imported into *Nova Scotia* and *New Brunswick*, and the Islands of *Cape Breton*, *Prince Edward*, and *Newfoundland*, from the Island of *Bermuda*.

[10th June 1811.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to extend to the Provinces of *Nova Scotia* and *New Brunswick*, the Island of *Cape Breton*, *Prince Edward's Island*, and the Island of *Newfoundland*, the Provisions of an Act passed in the Forty-ninth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to allow the Importation of Rum and other Spirits from the Island of Bermuda into the Province of Lower Canada without Payment of Duty, on the same Terms and Conditions as such Importation may be made directly from His Majesty's Sugar Colonies in the West Indies*; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That, from and after the passing of this Act, any Rum or other Spirits being the Produce or Manufacture of any of His Majesty's Sugar Colonies in the *West Indies*, legally and directly imported into the Island of *Bermuda* from His Majesty's Sugar Colonies in the *West Indies*, may be exported from thence into the Provinces of *Nova Scotia* and *New Brun-*
