Letter from Lieut Col Giegg Secretary Sc to GEORGE VANFELSON Esgr Advocate General, referred to in the foregoing Letter

> CARTLE OF ST LEWIS, Quebec, 12th February, 1831

I am commanded by His Excellency the Governor in Chief, to desire you will afford your professional assistance, in detending the Magistrates Mesers.
