tee of county council.

Mississauga reeve Chich Murray suggested the manor committee take a long hard look at retention of this clause.

"Who is to decide who is a resident and a nonresident of the county, especially in persons whose age would qualify them for entrance to the Home?" he asked.

'Where older people have families, it is difficult to establish resi-dence, when they are parcelled out to live with one member of the family and then move on to live with another," he argued. "This problem is com-

mon all over Canada not only in Peel County. The province has no such reg-

ulation."
M. C. Byrne, reeve of Toronto Gore, said the policy did have a bearing on a case in point where the Brampton Peel Manor was almost filled. If the second one was built there would be no prob-

Port Credit reeve Dave Hunter suggested also that the \$5 fee charged to elderly persons seeking entrance to the Home to cover medical fees, registration, and other necessary regulations could be removed. He said this fee would seem alot to people of limited funds and might in some cases cause a hardship.
