Head Quarters Kingston 26 July 1813.

The Commander of the forces has under his consideration the Report of a Board of Officers of which Brig^{de} General Vincent was President assembled by His Excellency's order at the Head Quarters of the Centre Division of the army at St. Davids the 20th July 1813 for the purpose of considering the Claims of the Indian Warriors in regard to Head Money for Prisoners of War brought in by them, & to the propriety of some provision being made for those who may be disabled on Service; With a View to Soften & Restrain the Indian Warriors in their conduct towards Americans as may be made by their Prisoners of War. His Excellency is pleased to Approve of the following arrangements Submitted by that Board & directs that the same may be acted upon Viz^t -

The Proceedings of a Council with the several Indian Warriors assembled at the 40 mile Creek on the 29th Ult^o having been presented to the Board, it is of opinion that upon the Subject of Head Money upon Prisoners of War brought in by Indians, Allowance should be made to them for each prisoner brought in alive, of five Dollars -

The Board is of Opinion the following rates of Pension are Sufficient

To a Chief for Loss of Eye limb
or receiving a Wound equal to loss
of limb } 100 Dollars ^{Pr. Annuum} in Money or presents

To a Warrior for Loss of Eye limb
or receiving a Wound equal to loss of limb } 70 Dollars ^{Pr. Annuum} in Money or presents

To the Widow of a Chief and
Family of a Chief Killed in action or Dying
of his wounds } a Present of 200 Dollars
or Goods

To the widow of a Warrior Killed
in action or Dying of his wounds } a present of 170 Dollars in
Money or Goods
