Sir-

Referring to your letter of the 5th Ultimo, relative to your desire to be located for land in the Walpole Island Indian Reserve, I beg to say that, under the Soldiers' Settlement Act, Lot No 266, Block H, was purchased for you and, until such time as your loan, in connection therewith, has been paid in full, the question of issue of Location Ticket to you for this land cannot be considered by the Department.

Lot No 351, St. Ann's Island, referred to by you, is not available and, in any event, it would not be considered advisable as being in your best interests to deal with the question of the allotment of further land to you until such time as you have made settlement in full for Lot No 266 and been duly located therefor.

The local agent has been fully instructed, in accordance with the foregoing.
