

Deputy Minister of Justice dated 25th April
1886. he stated he had a lengthy and intimate
with the population and had taken full
Memoranda of the difficulties as to the
title to their lands in Delaware and
had taken steps to ascertain how
they might best be rectified.

In 1887 it appears that the pre-
paration of this document commencing
the return of the Solicitor of the Department
from England. I have also to
request that you will have this matter

steps were taken in the matter at an
early date as you deem necessary.
