With Cheque

Ottawa, 14th October, 1910.

Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 4th instant I enclose herewith cheque No. 3345 for \$39.65 in your favor in payment of the two accounts submitted for the services of Police Magistrate James Scott and the constable employed in the case against Joseph Nicholas an Indian of the Rosseau River Band.

The Law Clerk of the Department taxed the accounts. In the case of the first mentioned account (rendered at \$22.20) the magistrate's fees have been passed at \$1.55 and the constable's at \$17.15. In connection with this account I may say that the first five items total \$1.55 not \$1.50. The item of \$1.00 for arrest has been eliminated from the account and the charge of \$4.00 for two days' guarding of prisoner has been reduced to \$2.00.

In the case of the second account the magistrate's fees have been passed at \$1.55 and the constable's at \$19.40. In this account the first five items total \$1.55 not \$1.50. \$1.00 instead of 50 cents has been allowed for attendance at Court. The charge made of \$4.00 made by the constable for two days' guarding of prisoner has been reduced to \$2.00.
