



Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letters of the 9th inst., with inclosed copies of resolutions passed by the Council of the Cape Croker Band in favour of permission being given to Wm. Macanquah to cut and sell pulpwood from land he is clearing, and to Charles Jones to cut 20 basswood and 2 engine trees for building purposes, and in reply to inform you that permits may be issued to them, but it will devolve on you to see that the conditions are fully complied with and that the timber is not otherwise disposed of.
