Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 20th instant, I beg to say that the Department approves of the proposed sale of a house and station belonging to David Boot Band No. 116, to Luke Keweenaw Band No. 96. It is observed that the purchase price is \$300.00 and that the purchaser proposes to make payment from his interest money as the sum falls due, \$20.00 to be paid at each distribution, until the full amount of the purchase money is received by Boot. When the money is paid it should be forwarded to the Department in order that a cheque may issue in Boot's favor. A note with regard to the transaction should be placed in the pay-list book. This letter should be quoted as authority.
