Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 20th instant, I beg to say that the Department approves of the proposed sale of a house and stables belonging to David Root Band No. 116, to Luke Kewegon Band No. 94. It is observed that the purchase price is \$300.00 and that the purchaser proposes to make payment from his interest moneys as the same fall due, \$20.00 to be paid at each distribution, until the full amount of the purchase money is received by Root. When the money is paid it should be forwarded to the Department in order that a cheque may issue in Root's favor. A note with regard to the transaction should be placed in the pay-list book.
