
OTTAWA. December 29th. 1919.

Dear Chief:-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd. inst. submitting an offer of \$300 for the buildings once owned by Mr. Henry Creelman and now included on the addition to the Truro Reserve.

In reply I have to state that Superintendent Boyd was instructed some time ago to visit this Reserve with a local surveyor and to solicit offers from the Indians of Halifax county for the lot and buildings referred to, and Mr. Cope should therefore interview or correspond with Mr. Boyd regarding his proposal.
