The real test for Canada may come this summer after we harvest 1946 erops.

If this year's crops are short, we as well as millions of other peoples throughout
the world may indeed be hungry. For our own bins will be bare, and our overseas
committments far above our capacity to supply.

Meanwhile, I do feel that we in Canada, may justly take some pride in what we are doing and what has been done. Let's remember that Britain's present plight is very largely due to promises of others which weren't fulfilled. Right now, Ottawa is wisely studying every phase of the food supply problem to make sure Canada doesn't make a similar error.
