

directly opposite Thompson Sound was a rocky, barren hillside, the site of an old village being however there. It was recommended that five acres be granted, to the south of the place known as Trafford Point, on the eastern end of Gilford Island. With respect to application R20, re. Hagakim or Haguinia, he could not recommend the transfer asked for; that reserve was used by the Kwicksitaneus only and should be confirmed to them. The land asked for in the Tilkya (F1) application was found to be apparently covered by crown grant and T. L. No. 10018; he would however recommend that, if available, ten acres be granted on each side of the river, for the old historic value of the Indians. This tribe had in all about 1665 acres altogether, including some very good land; there were 89 Indians in the Cape Mudge Band.

As to the applications put in by the Salmon River Band: "F2" was for an extension of the Salmon River Reserve, and as the land desired to be added was found to be alienated, the application could not be endorsed. Pakhaips was wanted for a fishing station, at the mouth of White River, but as the land affected was found to be alienated, the application could not be endorsed. The Tsatsumatsum application was endorsed, if the land were found to be vacant, as it apparently was; this was very good bottom land. There would be about 40 acres at the mouth of the river, the remainder of the land covered by the application being poor and rocky hillside. In consequence of alienation the applications for Mahpaik and Gwahiala, the latter being an old village on the Hastings' Company's Lot 49, could not be endorsed. At Quatselses, in T.L. No. 8719, he recommended that five acres be granted, the land being available, to include the old village site; this old village was near the northwestern end of Hardwicke Island, on Johnson Strait, on T. L. No. 8719, the village being visible from the water.

The land covered by the one application of the Kwathkaks, numbered "F3", was found to be alienated, for which reason this application was not recommended.
