6. Any person guilty of disorderly or criminal conduct can be expelled by a vote of two-thirds of the members present at a special meeting called for that purpose—such vote to be taken by ballot.

7. The rooms of the Institute may be furnished with books and periodicals, paintings, philosophical apparatus, &c., for the use of the members.

Lectures on any subject approved of by the Committee may be given by Members or Lecturers employed for the purpose at such times as the said Committee may determine.

8. This Constitution or any By-Law may be altered or amended at any General Meeting by a vote of two-thirds of the members present; notice of application for such alteration must in all cases be given to the Secretary one month previously, the notice to contain the exact terms of the alteration desired, and to be exhibited by the Secretary forthwith in the Library or rooms of the Institute; otherwise no alteration of the Constitution can be made.

Maps, plates, charts, etc., may be filmed at different reduction ratios. Those too large to be entirely included in one exposure are filmed beginning in the upper left hand corner, left to right and top to bottom, as many frames as required. The following diagrams illustrate the method:
