East Point.—200 yards inshore from S. part of point. Latitude 46° 27′ 9″. Longitude 61° 58′ 15″; white light revolving every 3 minutes, visible 17 miles. White octagonal tower wood.

New London.—1st. West side of entrance to Grenville Harbor. Latitude 46° 31′ 10″. Longitude 63° 28′ 45″; fixed red light, visible 10 miles, White square tower with dwelling attached.

2nd Range. Light 500 feet N. E. of main light; xed white light, visible 3 miles. White tower, square open frame.

Fish Island.—Entrance to Malpeque or Richmond Bay on inside of Island. Latitude 46° 84′ 44″. Longitude 68° 42′ 29″; two fixed white lights 400 yards apart E. by S. and W. by N., visible 12 miles. White square tower with dwelling attached.

Cascumpec.—S. W. part of Sandy Island. Latitude 46° 48′ 22″. Longitude 64° 2 15″; two fixed lights, 218 yards apart, E. by S. and W. by N. Main light white, visible 12 miles. White square wood tower with dwelling attached. Range light red, visible 6 miles, open framework, lantern white.

Lesser lights are situated at Summerside. (wharf), Crapaud, Orwell, Little Sands, Murray Harbor, St. Peter's Bay, Tracadie, South Rustico, North Rustico, Covehead, Little Channel, Tignish.

To be erected. One light at Cape Egmont. Range lights at Savage Harbor.
