MPROVED LARGE YORKSHIRES-Herd

If a rain came within a few days rass. after the seed were sown, something might be done, as soon as the ground dried up, with light harrows, or a weeder, but if the seeds had sprouted, great care should be taken not to disturb them. Perhaps the safest plan when seeding such a field is to have the surface harrowed, then, if a rain comes, and a crust forms, after it has dried off fairly well on top, run over it a roller with a small diameter. This will crush and pulverize the lumps, leaving a slight dust mulch. A roller of small diameter is best for crushing clods, because it grinds them down, whereas a large roller merely presses them into the surface. In using the roller, remember that rolling a dry crusted surface helps to form a dust mulch, which retains moisture in the soil below. Rolling a moist surface has the opposite effect. It compacts the soil producing a condition under which the soil moisture is drawn (by capillary at traction) to the very surface, and there evaporated by sun and air.

2. It is unlikely that the first sea son's growth on clay land would warrant cutting for hay. It will be better for next year's crop to clip the growth when six or eight inches high, or, at any rate before any weeds go to seed, and leave the clipping on the ground for a mulch It is harder to get a catch of alfalfa on heavy clay than on lighter soil, but once secured, it lasts longer and does better, as a rule.
