PROCLAMATION

BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.
Washington, May 31.
The President has issued the following Proclamation:
By the President of the United States of America—Whereas it has come to my knowledge that several military enterprises and expeditions are being carried on foot within the territory and jurisdiction of the United States with a view to carry on the same from such territory and jurisdiction, against the people and district of the Dominion of Canada within the Dominion of the Majesty the Queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, with whom the United States is at peace—Now, therefore, I, Ulysses S. Grant, President of the United States, do hereby admonish all citizens of the United States, and all persons within the military jurisdiction of the United States, against aiding, abetting, harboring, concealing, or taking part in such unlawful proceedings; and I do hereby warn all persons that by committing such illegal acts they are liable to all the penalties of the laws of the United States, and to the interference in their behalf to remove them from the consequences of their own acts; and I do hereby enjoin all officers and servants of the United States to employ all their lawful authority and power to prevent and defeat the same, and to bring to justice all persons who may be engaged therein.
