



As Palermo was being sentenced, there was a loud report from a flash light, and for a moment court and prisoners also were visibly startled. Sentence was pronounced on only two of the six counts charged in the indictments, and suspended in the others.

Lupo Morello and the others convicted to-day, are eight of the gang of seventeen, nine of whom were arrested last year, are now awaiting trial. t is charged that they floated nearly \$500,000 worth of counterfeit bills, which they peddled at 25 cents on the dollar. To Lupo the police credit two murders in this country, one of which was the famous "Barrel Murder." Comito Frinter, of the gang, turned state's evidence, and will probably be placed on trial separately. It has been predicted that if freed his life will pay for the evidence he gave.


