The natural intelligence of Newfoundlanders is simply marvellous and the results that would be obtained if a really effort were made to develop that intelligence would be most remarkable. It has been suggested that Greece be given Constantinople as no other nation has a better title to that city. This is a proposal that which should find favor everywhere. It will be monstrous if the Turk is to be allowed to remain in Europe after the horrors that he has inflicted upon the Christian population for centuries, and as Greece appeals to the imagination of mankind more than any other nation in the near East, it would be most fitting if the great port of the Bosphorus should be turned over to her. Civilization and Christianity would once more be enthroned where heathenism and vile tyranny so long held sway. 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standing. These people would have rebuked the Saviour if they had been present at the marriage feast of Cana. I hope the gallant Newfoundland soldiers will go into politics and elect some of their heroes to office. The country would be safe in the hands of men who suffered martyrdom for the sake of liberty, and no honour is too great to bestow upon them. I have often thought of the South as a great potential market for Newfoundland herring. The negro population consumes enormous quantities of sardines at fancy prices, and I believe they would soon develop a liking for herring if it were placed on this market. These statements may be far-fetched and I am merely making them for what they are worth. The Salvation Army has covered itself with glory because of its work at the battlefronts. The soldiers are enthusiastic over the broad-minded manner in which its war-service was performed. There was none of the irksome restrictions that have irritated many of our men, and no namby-pamby diatribes against the evils of nicotine, etc. The Salvation Army regarded the soldiers as men and not as snivelling, canting molly-coddles. As a consequence our men swear by the organization. And among its defenders are staunch K. of G. men, whose own organization followed the same lines as the Salvation Army and achieved equally remarkable results. I have been told by various Protestants and Catholics that there never was at any time in the world's history such an absence of ill-feeling between the different denominations. A story is told of a Protestant Chaplain risking his life and limb to drag a wounded Catholic priest to safety under the concentrated fire of the German trenches. Could anything be more sublime than that!

Intolerance, whether it is supported by Jew or Gentile, Protestant or Catholic, is the curse of the world. Thank God it is passing along with the atheistical teachings of half-baked philosophers and materialists. If we do not breathe a purer, sweeter atmosphere after the horrors which hell let loose upon us then God help the world. Henry Ford has retired from active participation in the great industry which bears his name and has launched a weekly review called the "Dearborn Independent." It seems rather strange to think of Ford as a journalist but he has wealth enough to buy the world's best brains. A great many thoughtful people believe the South is slumbering over a volcano which may burst into eruption at any moment. Northern agitators who are so loudly advocating equal political and social rights to Southern negroes have given the other side of the question the slightest attention. The South has many negroes who are intelligent and respectable, but it also has a horde of degenerate, illiterate blacks who are only held back from rebellion and massacre by their fear of the whites. Once let these negroes become certain of success and the massacres during the Indian mutiny will become insignificant beside the orgies of bloodshed which would follow. There is a slumbering hatred of the white race in the minds of these people who are just as ferocious as were their ancestors in the dark jungles of Africa. One can see it in their eyes and in their hideous leering expression when a reproof is given them. Many of them are ninety per cent beast, and hesitate not to indulge their beastly appetites once they are assured of immunity from punishment. The black African savage is a barbarian but his animal passions are held in check to a greater extent than those of his degraded descendants in the Southern States. The idea of placing these beasts on an equality with the whites is unthinkable. The horrible results which followed the Reconstruction period after the Civil War is not forgotten. At that time Northern agitators taking advantage of the disenchanted of the Southern whites filled the State legislatures with blacks. Ignorant of the first rudiments of law-making they carried the vilest sort of their unscrupulous white leaders. So fraught with menace to the well-being of the States were some of the measures passed that heroic measures were taken by the whites to rid the South of the curse of black rule. The Ku-Klux-Klan was one of the organizations formed by the whites for self-protection, an organization the name of which even now strikes terror into the heart of the negro. The fighting in and around Charleston was terrific but the whites succeeded in removing the curse of black ascendancy. The Germans did not hesitate to try to stir up bloody massacre in the South during the late war. White girls were promised as prizes to the black beasts who were urged to kill and ravish to their hearts content. This plan proved abortive, however, when the details of German treatment of the Belgians penetrated the thick skins of the blacks. What enthusiasm they may have had for the plan of the German government was dampened by the fear that in case the Germans won, they would be slaves again. The Teuton devils once again over-ruled themselves, but at the same time they implanted more firmly the negro's hatred of the white man. The military prowess of the blacks during the late war has also increased their bumps of conceit and, given the right opportunity, they will not hesitate to descend like a horde of demons upon the unsuspecting white population. Southern ladies have told me that they no longer have confidence in their negro servants, especially their cooks, so terrible is the new-born hatred for the whites. The negroes from the neighbouring West India Islands seem far more tractable and intelligent, while in Bermuda they have reached a high degree of intelligence and even culture. Jamaica has many negroes of the animal type but the pains for depravity must be given to the negro of the Southern States. The race question is a difficult one to solve but its proper solution does not lie in the methods advocated by ill-informed Northern agitators who weep crocodile tears over what they call "Southern tyranny."
