

## GIVE DAY'S PAY TO BELGIAN RELIEF

The County Council Members  
Donate \$120 To Aid the  
War's Destitute.

EXPENSES — \$356,090.11

Alterations to Court House  
Make Big Hole in Receipts  
of Year.

The Middlesex county council, on the motion of John McGugan, last night, decided unanimously to contribute one day's pay for the thirty councillors, to the Belgian Relief Fund. The donation amounts to \$120.

**Asked Resignation.**  
The keeper of the Middlesex Home of Refuge at Stratford, and the inspector, Malcolm McGugan, will be asked to step "on the mat" before the council this afternoon, to explain the working of the institution. The council asked for the resignation of the keeper of the Home of Refuge, on the score that expenses of the institution were excessive, and that the council had been recommended at other sessions, to examine the running of the home. The home is on a farm of 53 acres, which councillors declared did not yield nearly as large a crop as it should.

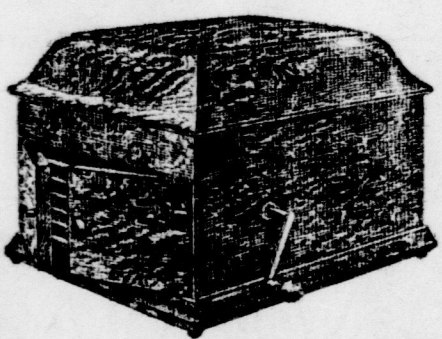
Fred Laughton recommended that the work of the keeper and of the farmer, who is in charge of the farm work, be combined, after a suitable report had been found. The matter will be thrashed out today. The report of Victoria Hospital, showed that the maintenance of the institution cost \$1,600 less this year than in 1913. There are six county patients now in the hospital. A resolution was adopted to pass a by-law, giving H. J. Baron, representative of the Southern Gas Company, permission to lay a pipe line along the county road between Westminster and North Dorchester, for a gas supply for the village of Belmont and residents along the line.

The receipts and expenditures of the County of Middlesex from January 1 to December 7, 1914, show receipts of \$322,495.08, the balance from 1913 being \$38,595.32. Expenditures were \$356,090.11. The main expense of the year was the county's share in the alterations to the court house amounting to \$32,400.

## CLAREMONT HORSE GUELPH CHAMPION

"Baron Ascot" Takes Premier  
Honors — The Clydesdale  
Show's Feature.

GUELPH, Dec. 10. — The Winter Fair of 1914 is a thing of the past. The house through the filled buildings each day were loud in the praises of the show. The exhibitors declare it to have been the best yet. While a slight decrease in the attendance has been noted, this has been wholly accounted for on account of the war conditions prevailing throughout the Dominion.

The show was paid out tonight by a large staff of bank clerks, and by morning it is expected that all will have been paid. Tonight's program was exclusively taken up by awarding championship prizes, and all exhibitors expressed themselves as perfectly satisfied with the result.

**Won Championship.**  
Baron Ascot carried off the grand championship for the best horse in the show. Graham Bros., Claremont, are the owners of this handsome Clydesdale stallion, and this marvel of prize he has won the unanimous applause of all present.

**Stock Improving.**  
That Canadian live stock is improving in quality was amply demonstrated at the show, while poultry experts are united in their opinion when they state that the poultry show was the best ever held in Canada.

The farmers have taken more interest in their own show and have flocked from all over Ontario. "I could only get away for the day," declared one of this afternoon, "but I have been more than repaid for coming all the way from Stratford. It is the best show I have ever seen." Tim He but a sample of the general consensus of opinion among the farmers, and it is quite safe to say that next year the fair will be better than ever.

**Ontario's Chance.**  
That opportunities for Canadian livestock, especially in Ontario, were never brighter than they were today, was the opinion expressed by all the speakers who addressed the farmers on livestock in the lecture-room this afternoon.

Robert Miller, Stratford, spoke on the horse industry. He declared that there had been very little doing in it for some time. However, there was never very much activity in the business at this time of the year. A number of horses that had been used in the building trade had nothing to do, now that operations had ceased to a great extent. The fact that there was no railroad construction going on at present also threw a great many horses on the market. Farming had not expanded in the west, and thus he was quite safe in saying that things were quiet for the Ontario horse breeder, although the speaker was firmly convinced that the traction engine could never take the place of the horse on the western farm.

**Not Much Difference.**  
Mr. Miller stated that in his opinion the war had not made any material difference to the horse industry as yet. When war was declared the farmers were loath to let their animals go in mid-season, when they were most needed on the farm, and that later on it was too late, as the required number had been bought. The British war office had started buying its horses in Canada, but that it was discovered that American animals were being sold to its buyers on the Toronto market, and although inquiries had been made, the source of these animals could not be ascertained. As the horses from the other side appeared to be just as good as Canada's, the buyers left and bought the same class of horse in the United States, \$10 to \$100 cheaper. The speaker declared that, although there were twenty-four million horses in the United States apparently suited for war purposes, yet they could not stand the hardships and work that Canadian horses could.

"If we don't reduce our prices, we can't expect to get the trade," continued Mr. Miller. "They will be buying 1,000 horses a week for a third contingent pretty soon, and they will be horses that we can easily do without. There is an almost inexhaustible supply of horses in Canada and the United States as long as the war lasts. United States and Russia have over half of the horses in the world."

**The Horse Trade.**  
"The future of the horse breeding industry is just what the Canadian farmer likes to make it. There will be a greater demand from the west soon. The tide of immigration is flowing this way, and houses must be built for the people coming to our shores. It is surprising the number of horses used in the building and lumbering business."

"There will be a new market created for horses owing to the tremendous wastage in France. We are told by military experts that the average life of a horse at the front is but four months. This means that it would take half the horses in Great Britain to conduct the war for a year. This is where the Ontario farmer will have his chance. The demand will be there, and if we prepare accordingly we will be all right, for there is no more critical judge of horseflesh than the Briton. He is willing to pay well for the best, and he is willing to let you know it."

**Great Opportunities.**  
John Gardhouse, Weston, spoke on the opportunity of beef cattle. He declared that the world over there was a great shortage of good beef cattle. He had been estimated that in the last eight years there had been a decrease of a million and a half cattle in the States, while conditions in the country now are such that the industry is more serious, but that in Canada there had been an increase of 27 per cent in beef cattle.

Mr. Gardhouse stated that there were a number of reasons why cattle market had decreased, among them being the dry season, the war, scarcity of money, and the foot-and-mouth disease. "What is likely to happen?" asked Mr. Gardhouse. "The farmers will want to save feed, and will kill their immature animals, and some breeding ones as well. That should be saved. A lot of this has been taking place. They should look well into the future and not sacrifice what might be of benefit to them later on, as it is probable that there will be a shortage in the beef supply. It is just as important to the farmer to provide food for the country as it is for him to go to war."

He made an appeal to the stockmen to breed nothing but the best animals, declaring that the other provinces were looking to Ontario for their foundation stock.

**The Dairy Cattle.**  
The subject of dairy cattle, was attended to by F. Stephens, Quebec, who declared that although Canada needed beef cattle and horses, yet she needed dairy products infinitely more. He stated that the dairyman's profits were not exceptionally large, yet there was a good comfortable living in the business. Although the dairy industry had been surrounded by rules and regulations, and increased expenditures, yet it had a great future with quality counting as never before. The export of dairy products had decreased and he quoted statistics to show that Canada was consuming nearly all her dairy products. Mr. Stephens was of the opinion that the dairy industry was beginning to find out how unprofitable it was to keep poor cows, since milk testing had become a regular thing. He advised farmers to keep pure bred sires. "Keep your herd up to the maximum standard," concluded Mr. Gardhouse.

**Should Not Stampede.**  
R. H. Harding, Thorndale, who spoke on sheep declared the farmer should not be stampeded in sheep as he had been in the last few years, stating that sheep were worth double today what they were thirteen years ago. "Every farmer should have at least a small flock of sheep on his farm. They are the greatest of scavengers, eating up 90 per cent of the weeds. I believe that the country will be up against a shortage of wool after the war. It is up to us to increase both the quantity and the quality."

**Dressed Competition.**
