THE IRISH PARTY AND HOME RULE.

A Circular issued suggesting Mr. Gladstone to Confer with the Home Rule Party. LONDON, March 1.—The accompanying statement of the committee of the Irish party in Parliament was given out late last night. The purpose of the statement is to define the attitude of the party on the main Irish question—Home Rule. It is a withdrawal from office.

"No such excitement has been created by rumors concerning the position of Mr. Gladstone that it may be well to point out that the Irish members remain calm, because in the judgment there really is no mystery in the matter, no occasion for surprise or sensation.
