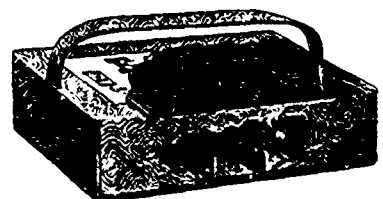

M. R. C. J. DANIELS, Toronto, has shown us a new egg shipping box which is fairly depicted here. The beauty of it is that by a patent catch, or lock, once the handle is inserted in the box
