The undersigned, a Committee appointed by your honorable body on the twenty-second day of December, 1897, to examine the Annual Statement of the Company, and to verify the same, respectfully,

### REPORT

That, pursuant to the power and authority thereto conferred, the Committee have at various dates between the date of the said reference, and the date of this Report, attended at the office of the Company, and have been waited on by the Treasurer, the Controller, the Auditor and the Cashier, together with the respective assistants of such officers, and have carefully gone over all the items contained in the said Statement, and have found the same to be correct. They have examined and certified every certificate of stock, bond and other obligation held by the Company, and compared the prices at which the same are carried in said Statement with the market quotations, and find the same to exceed such quotations, in fact, in many cases below them. They have examined and certified the bonds and mortgages on real property held by the Company, and find the same to be as stated. They have also verified the valuation of the Company's holdings of real estate and have verified the deposits of money in the various banks and trust companies, and have counted the cash on hand held by the Cashier.
