Note: Except in those cases where Canada has been elected to a body for a term ending at some specific point after 1967, its membership (x) or non-membership is only shown through 1967. Canada also belongs to the Disarmament Commission and the Committee for the Review of the Charter, but, since these are Committees-of-the-whole, they have not been listed above.

(a) Members elected as individuals on the basis of personal qualifications and not as representatives of member states.

(b) Members elected for an indefinite period.

(c) Established as a UN body.

(d) United Nations Refugee Fund Executive Committee discontinued on December 31, 1957, and United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees Executive Committee set up to replace it.

(e) Committee on Peaceful Uses of Outer Space is a successor to an *ad hoc* committee established in 1958; Canada was a member of the *ad hoc* committee.

(f) The other Standing Committee is the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions, but a Canadian has not served on it as yet.

(g) The Industrial Development Board was established as the executive body of the new United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) at the twenty-first session of the General Assembly. UNIDO came into existence on January 1, 1967.
